RBC Indigenous Student Award Program	All	This scholarship is intended to support Indigenous students who have a minimum of 2 years remaining in their post-secondary studies. Shannen's Dream Scholarship	All	The Shannen's Dream Scholarship is an award to assist First Nations youth with post-secondary education costs (university, college, trades). First Nations, Métis and Inuit Bursaries	Concordia University	The First Nations, Inuit and Métis Bursary program is intended to recognize and reward full-time students in Bachelor's programs in any area of study, who are in financial need and acceptable academic standing. New Sun Joy Harvie Maclaren Graduate Entrance Award	McGill University	Preference will be given to Canadian Indigenous students studying nutrition, dietetics, agriculture or environmental sciences on the Macdonald Campus. The award is renewable for one year at the M.Sc. level and two years at the Ph.D. level pending satisfactory standing and full-time status.
